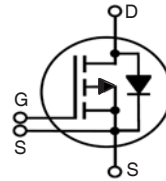

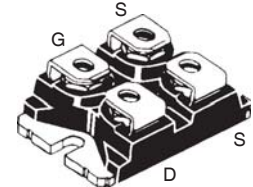

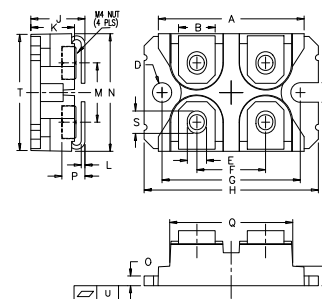

Fig. 1. Output Characteristics @ $T_J = 25^\circ\text{C}$

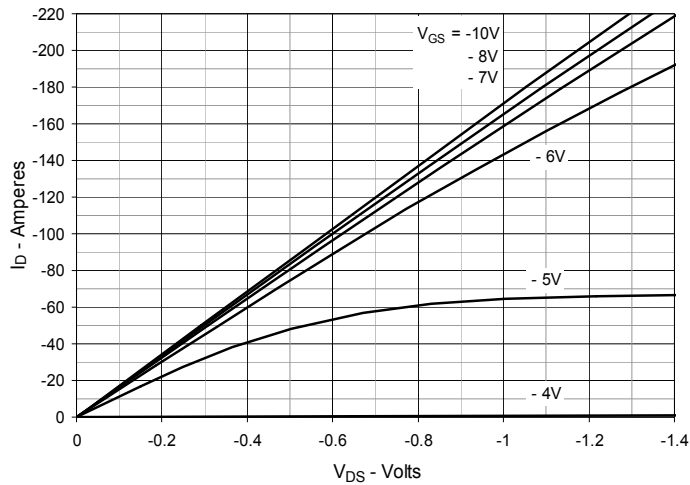


Fig. 2. Extended Output Characteristics @ $T_J = 25^\circ\text{C}$

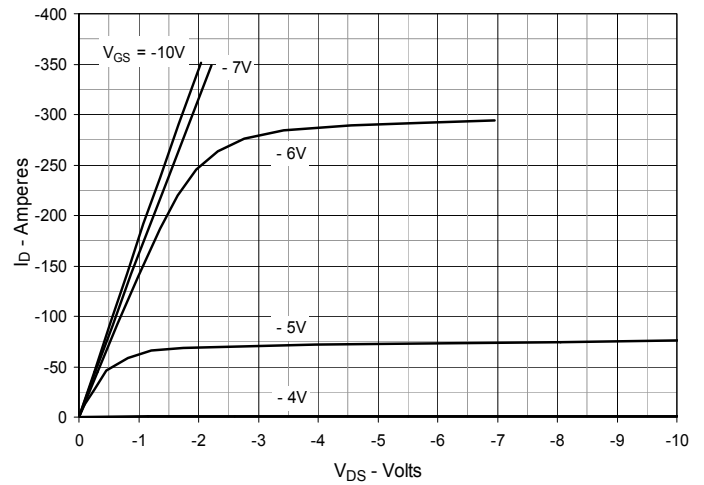


Fig. 3. Output Characteristics @ $T_J = 125^\circ\text{C}$

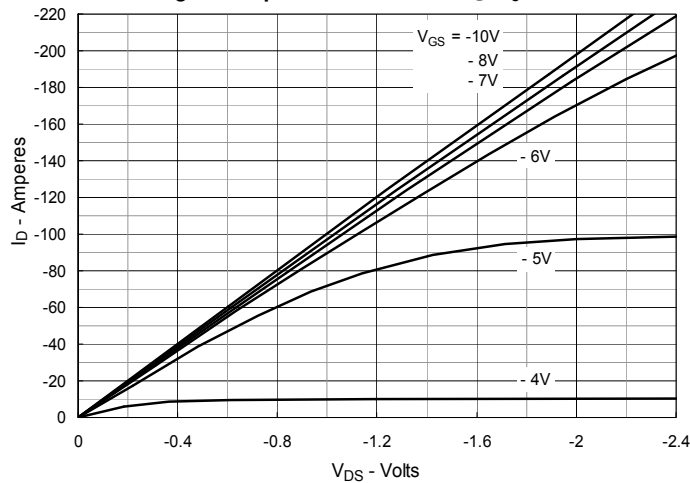


Fig. 4. $R_{DS(on)}$ Normalized to $I_D = -105\text{A}$ Value vs. Junction Temperature

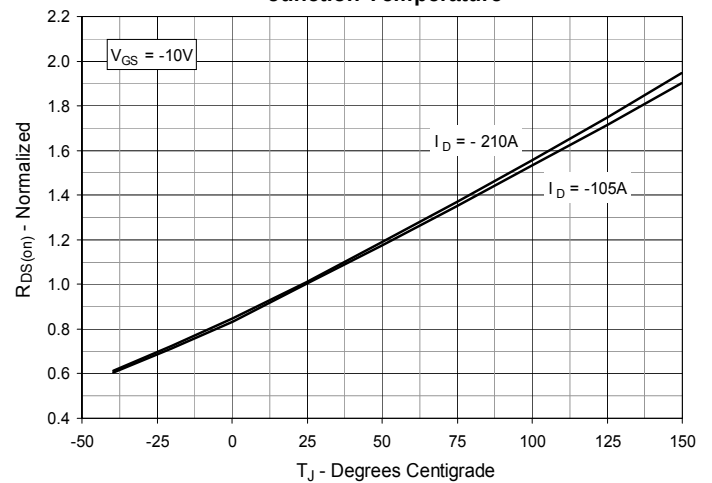


Fig. 5. $R_{DS(on)}$ Normalized to $I_D = -105\text{A}$ Value vs. Drain Current

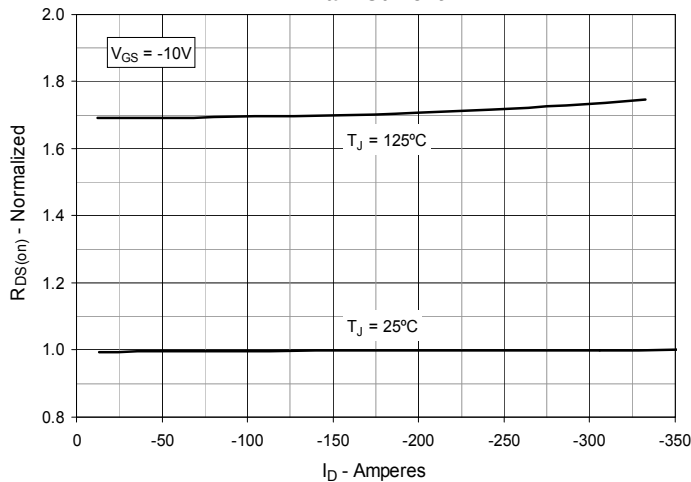


Fig. 6. Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature

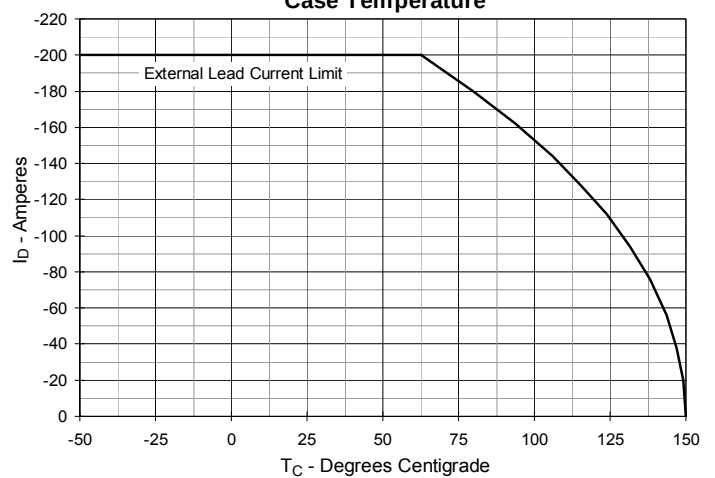


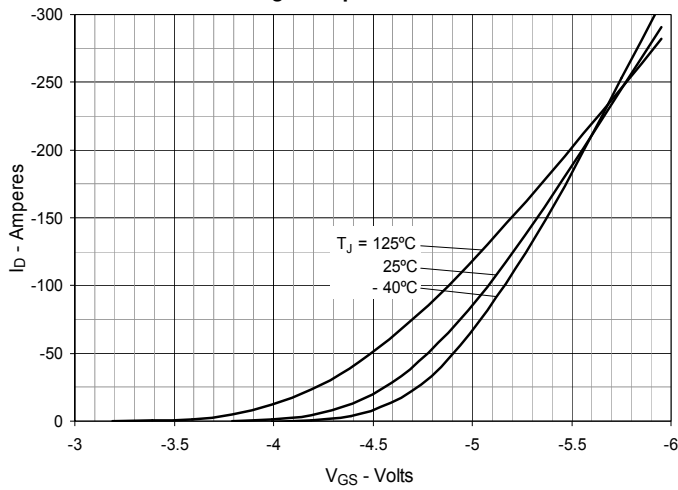
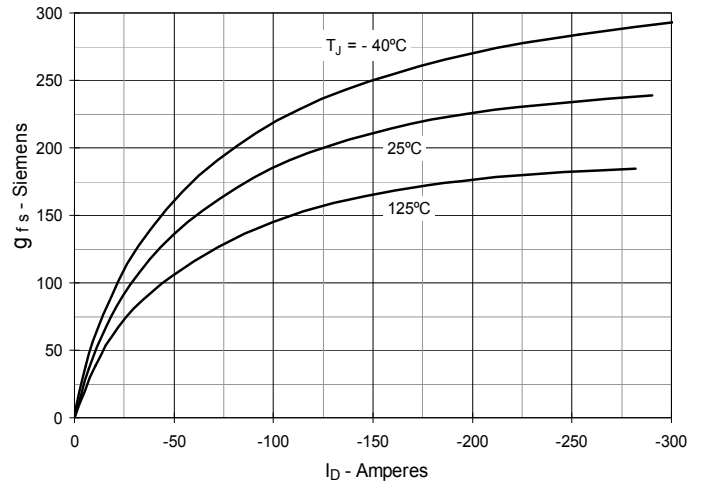
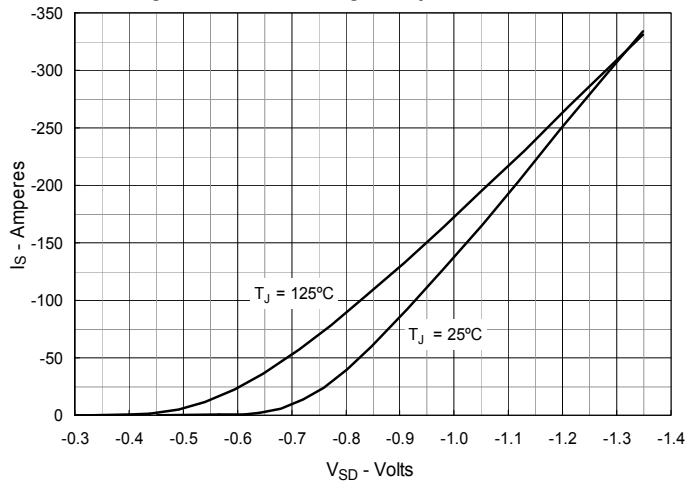
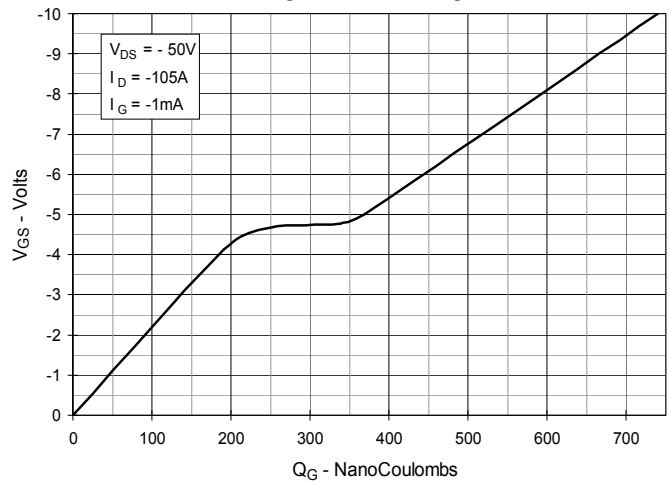
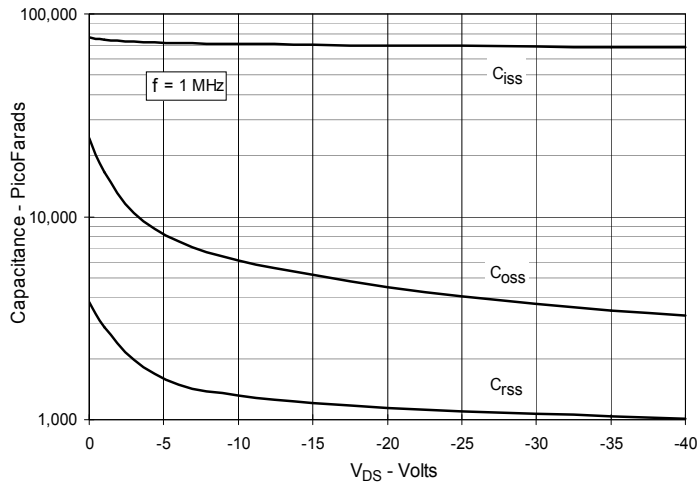
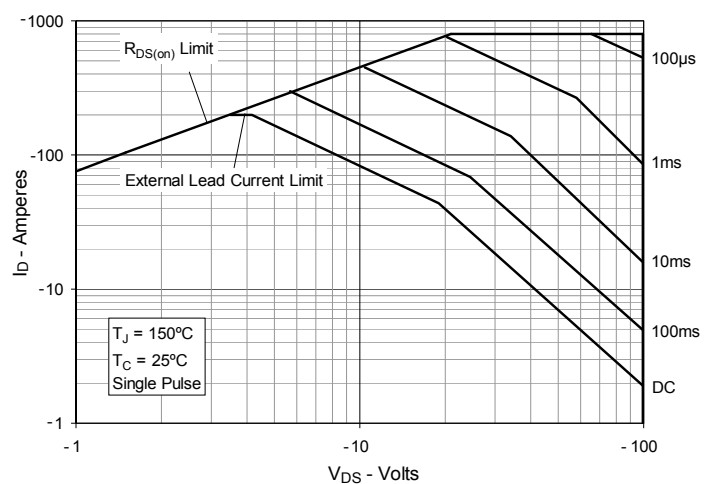
Fig. 7. Input Admittance

Fig. 13. Resistive Turn-on Rise Time vs. Junction Temperature

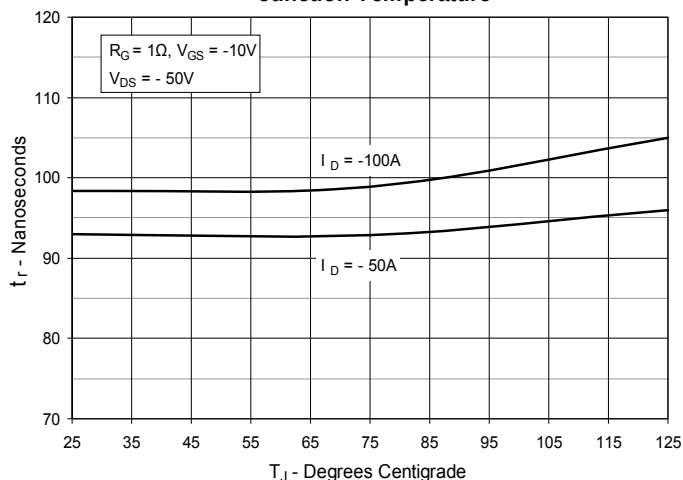


Fig. 14. Resistive Turn-on Rise Time vs. Drain Current

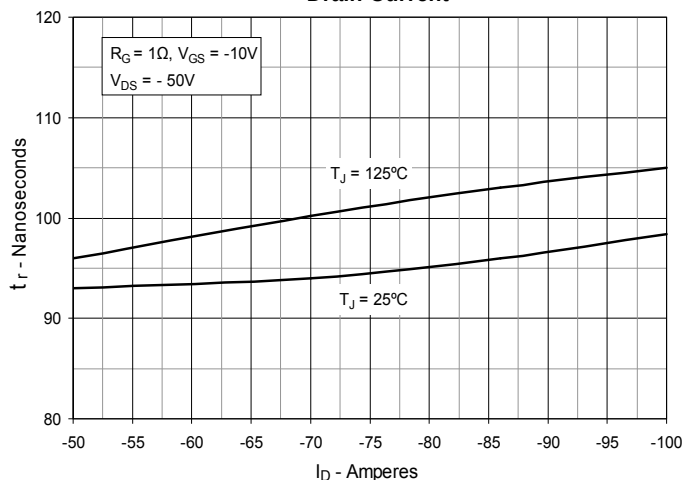


Fig. 15. Resistive Turn-on Switching Times vs. Gate Resistance

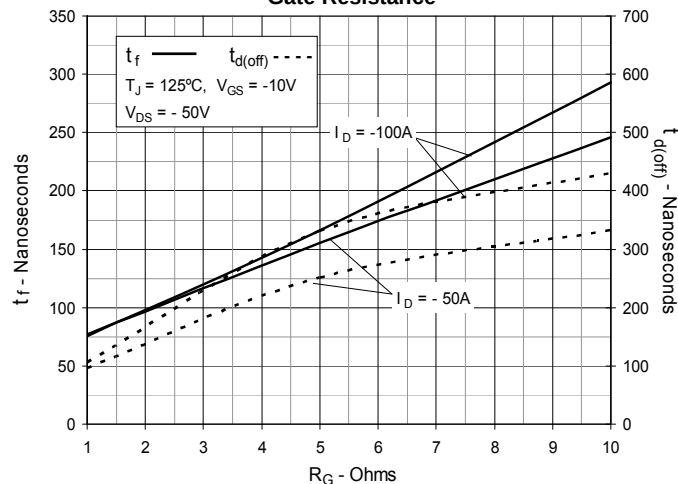


Fig. 16. Resistive Turn-off Switching Times vs. Junction Temperature

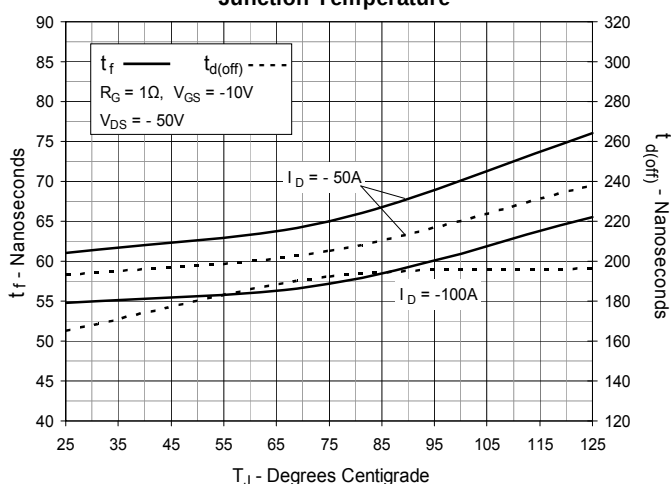


Fig. 17. Resistive Turn-off Switching Times vs. Drain Current

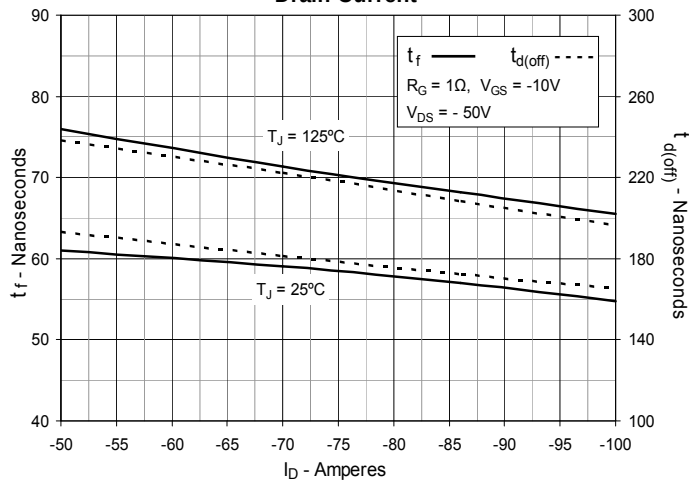


Fig. 18. Resistive Turn-off Switching Times vs. Gate Resistance

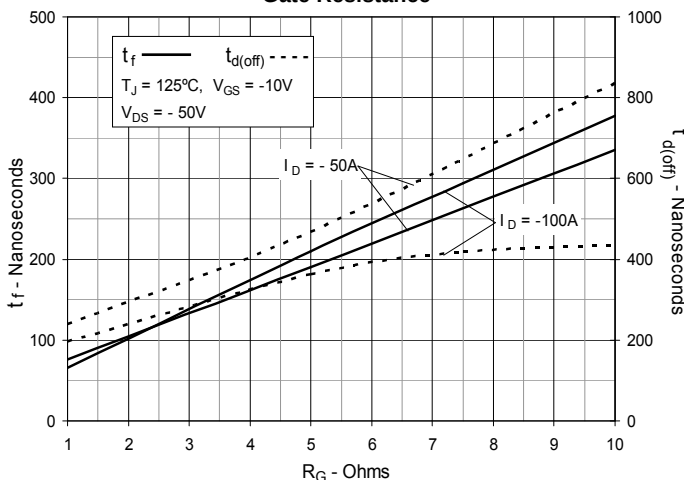
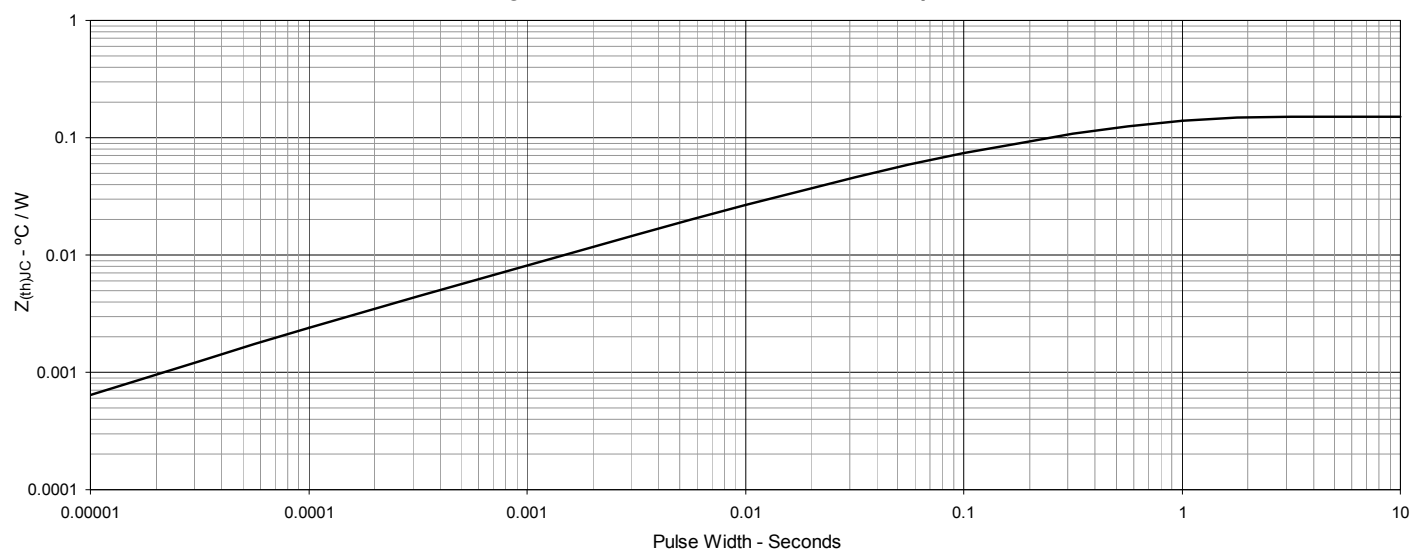


Fig. 19. Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance





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
