

# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SYMCOM'S MOTORSAVER MODEL 50R-400-ALT ALTERNATING RELAY

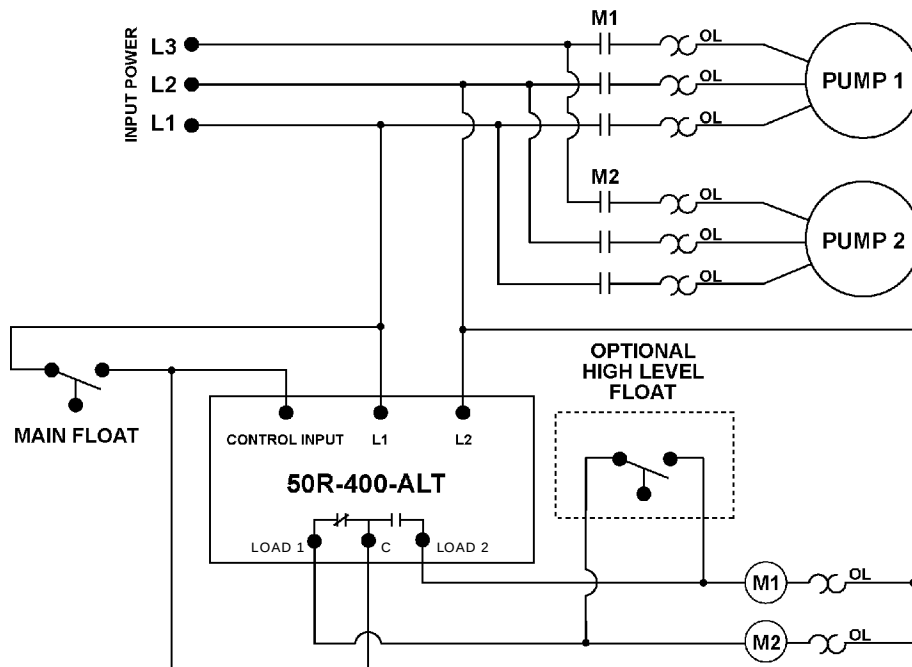

The Model 50R-400-ALT alternating relay is used to alternate between two loads, most commonly in duplex pumping and compressor applications to balance the runtime of both loads. The 470VA @ 600VAC pilot duty rated relay eliminates the need for a control power transformer. When used in dual-float applications, the alternating relay will allow both pumps to run simultaneously when both floats are closed.

## **CONNECTIONS**

1. Mount the MotorSaver in a convenient location in or near the motor control panel. If the location is wet or dusty, the MotorSaver should be mounted in a NEMA 4 or 12 enclosure.
2. Connect the lines of the power supply to L1 and L2 on the MotorSaver's terminal strip.
3. Connect the common relay terminal to the main float and CONTROL POWER input on the Model 50R-400-ALT. Connect LOAD 1 and LOAD 2 to the contactor coils as shown in Figure 1.
4. Connect an additional float (optional) to LOAD 1 and LOAD 2. This configuration will allow both pumps to run if both floats are closed.

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OPERATION

The Model 50R-400-ALT alternating relay changes state each time the float switch opens. It will not switch states while current is flowing. Switching only occurs after current has been sensed, followed by loss of current for the duration of the debounce time delay. The debounce time delay (1 sec.) feature prevents the alternating relay from changing state if the float contact bounces momentarily.

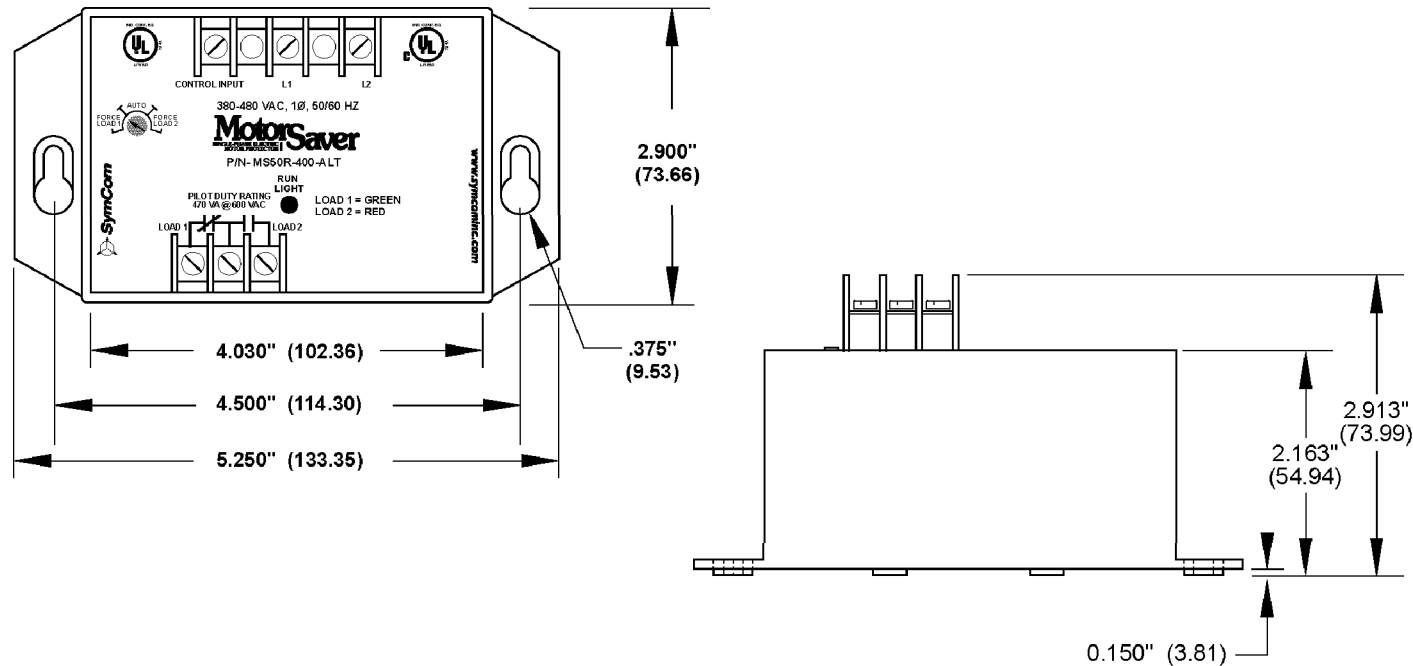
The Model 50R-400-ALT can be configured to alternate between two pumps or to force one pump to run every time the float closes. This can be useful when removing a pump for maintenance or repair.

In dual-float applications, the alternating relay will allow both pumps to run simultaneously when both floats are closed.
